Reception and Y1 visit to Cromer

10th July 2012

Dear Parents and Carers,

Here is a reminder of the details for the visit to Cromer tomorrow:

- We will leave school at 9.30am and return before the end of the school day.
- We have booked an indoor venue (with toilets) to return to for lunch.
- The purpose of the visit is to explore the beach, **we will not be paddling or going in the sea.**
- All children must bring a packed lunch and a drink, unless your child has free school meals and you have already ordered a meal at the office.
- Children must wear sensible shoes for the visit as they will be walking from the drop off point to the beach twice. Please do not send your child in flip flops as we have to walk down the slopes to get to the sea front as well as use steps to access the beach.
- Please remember the beach is always a bit cooler than Norwich. The weather is due to be cloudy so please make sure your child wears a school cardigan or a school jumper.
- Despite the cooler weather forecast **please ensure your child comes to school with sun cream on and wears a hat.** We will take extra sun cream if needed – please speak to your child's teacher if they have sensitive skin / allergies to sun creams.
- Children may bring a bucket and spade. As we could take 140 buckets and spades I advise you name these before sending them to school. Please speak to your child about looking after these as they will be responsible for carrying them to and from the beach.
- Finally, we are going to explore the beach, build sand castles and have fun on a section of the beach patrolled by lifeguards. Whilst we do not plan on children getting wet, we will take some towels for emergencies. I am sure you will understand we will not have time to change children into fresh clothes before returning to school which is why we have not requested a change of clothes. The school always takes spare clothes for emergencies or accidents on school visits.

We look forward to returning to school with many happy memories and experiences. Please see your child's teacher, or the headteacher (the visit leader) if you have any questions.
